

## Student Access

Teachers have many ways to give their students access.

### 1) **Quizzes & Assignments:**

- a. The teacher creates a quiz or an assignment. This might be an actual test or maybe just a review. A quiz is made up of video segments and then a quiz. Assignments can have any items from Streamline – video segments, articles, images, quizzes etc. and even web pages of the teacher’s choice.
- b. The quiz or assignment is automatically assigned a passcode (number) in Step 5.
- c. The teacher can email a direct link to the quiz or assignment or give the students this URL <http://streaming.discoveryeducation.com/studentcenter> and the quiz or assignment passcode.
- d. Student goes to the URL and puts in the passcode.
- e. Student puts in their first and last name.
- f. At end, results are found in the teacher’s My Content area in Streamline for each of their quizzes and assignments.

### 2) **Single School Student Account for Research:**

Each school may have a student account that the teacher may allow the students to use for research projects, PowerPoint presentations, making their own movies with “editable” segments, or telling a story with pictures. There only needs to be one student account per school unless the school is very large. The account may be used by any number of students simultaneously **at school only, under the teacher’s direction**. It is not to be used by the student at home. This account information should not be shared with anyone outside the school.

(Note: Be aware that there are videos on the site for grades K to 12.)

- a. A Department Head or Account Admin on the Streamline site may go to the Admin site, select any teacher at a school, click edit, and there will be a Student Passcode at the top of that information page.
- b. Use that passcode to create a student account for the school. Just put in that passcode on the ETV StreamlineSC home page ([etv.streamlinesc.org](http://etv.streamlinesc.org)) and complete the form.
- c. You may wish to use the school name as the username (WoodElem or HerbertWood) and a color or mascot for the password.

### 3) Teachers may **download video segments and images** and allow students to view them on computers in the classroom, in a lab, or at home.

- a. Burn the downloaded video segments to CD or save to USB Flash drives to transport to all of the computers in the classroom or to a lab or to take home.
- b. Save to a network drive that the students have access to and let the students pull the videos from that drive.
- c. Save to a handheld video device for viewing individually with headphones.

### 4) And use your **imagination**. The assignment just has to be “teacher directed”.

### 5) You may NOT put the videos or other items from Streamline on an open web site. It is permissible, if the website is password protected and to be used by educators, parents and students within a South Carolina school district. (Follow guidelines above in **Quizzes & Assignments** 1. c.)
